## About Marko

- Marko has been the Vice President of the FCI Rescue Dog Commission since 2019. From 2009 to 2019 he was President of the Slovenian Rescue Dog Association. An international rescue dog judge, he has judged over 100 RH trials, including the 2021 FCI RH World Championship and national mission-ready tests.
- Marko has been training rescue dogs since the early 1990s. He has competed in the world championship multiple times, including in 2005 in France (4th place) and 2007 in Austria (7th place).
- In addition to his extensive work in Slovenia, he has trained rescue dogs for various SAR organizations in Abu Dhabi, Switzerland, Austria, and Russia, among other countries. Further, he served as Chief Trainer for rescue dogs, rubble and area search, in St. Petersburg, Russia in 2017.
- In addition to being a judge and rescue dog trainer, he has participated as a dog handler or team leader on more than 80 area search missions, including the Sumatra earthquake in 2009, the Turkey earthquake in February 2023, and most recently the floods in Libya.
- Between 2010 and 2022, he trained more than 20 service dogs as either guide dogs or mobility task-trained SDs for varying disabilities.
- Between 2010 and 2016, he also judged drug and explosives detection dogs at the International Police Search Dog Championship.
